Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

What is a "Chrome" Rigger glove? "Chrome" refers to the chrome-tanning process used on the leather. This method makes the leather more resistant to heat and moisture compared to vegetable-tanned alternatives, ensuring the glove stays supple and durable even after getting damp.

What size are these gloves? Most Classic Chrome Riggers are "One Size Fits All" (typically a Large/XL). They are designed with a loose fit to allow for quick removal and to accommodate different hand sizes comfortably.

Are these gloves waterproof? No. While the leather provides some resistance to light moisture, the cotton backing is breathable and will absorb water. For wet-weather work, we recommend looking for a fully coated or membrane-lined waterproof glove.

Do they offer cut protection? They offer a basic level of protection against minor cuts and scrapes (Level 1 or 2 under EN 388). If you are working with glass or sharp sheet metal, you should look for a dedicated High-Cut (Level D-F) glove.

User Hints & Pro-Tips

- **Break-In Period:** Like a good pair of boots, leather rigger gloves can feel a bit stiff at first. Give them an hour of use, and the heat from your hands will soften the leather for a custom-molded fit.
- **Storage:** Avoid leaving them on a radiator to dry. Rapid heat can cause the leather to become brittle and crack. Let them air dry naturally.

- **Safety First:** The loose-fitting cuff is a safety feature. If the glove gets caught in moving machinery, your hand should be able to slide out while the glove stays behind.
