Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

Q: Why only 3 fingers open?

A: The thumb, index, and middle fingers are the "precision" fingers used for picking up small objects or using touchscreens. The remaining two fingers stay covered to provide protection when gripping tools or leaning against rough surfaces.

Q: Are these gloves suitable for heavy construction?

A: These are "Specialist Multi-Task" gloves designed for dexterity. While they offer good abrasion resistance, for heavy demolition or high-heat tasks, we recommend a fully enclosed rigger or leather driver glove.

Q: Can I wash these gloves?

A: Yes, the synthetic leather can typically be hand-washed in cool water with mild soap. Air dry them away from direct heat to prevent the synthetic materials from becoming brittle.

Pro-Tips & User Hints

- **The "Framer's" Choice:** These are excellent for framers and carpenters who need to handle nails or screws but want palm protection from splinters and tool vibration.
- **Check the Knuckles:** When sizing, ensure the **neoprene knuckle panel** sits directly over your knuckles. This ensures the glove flexes correctly and doesn't pull at the fingertips.

- **Debris Guard:** Use the Velcro strap to create a tight seal at the wrist. This prevents sawdust, metal filings, or grit from falling inside the glove while you work.
