Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

Q: Why is protection only in the left hand? A: Standard safety protocol (Design A/Type 2) places the protective inlay on the back of the left hand, as this is the hand most frequently exposed to the chain if a "kickback" occurs while the right hand remains on the rear handle/trigger.

Q: What does "Class O" mean? A: Chainsaw PPE is rated by the chain speed it can withstand. Class O is rated for speeds up to **16m/s**. This is typically suitable for smaller petrol saws or electric/battery-operated chainsaws.

Q: Can these gloves be washed? A: It is recommended to wipe leather gloves with a damp cloth. Avoid machine washing or using heavy detergents, as this can strip the natural oils from the leather and cause it to become brittle, potentially compromising the protective fibres.

Expert Hints & Maintenance

- **The "Pinch" Test:** Periodically check the protective inlay on the left hand. If you feel any lumps or shifts in the internal padding, or if the outer leather is deeply cut, the glove should be replaced immediately.
- **Storage:** Always store your gloves in a dry, cool place away from direct sunlight. UV rays and moisture can degrade both the leather and the internal protective fibres over time.
- **Visibility Tip:** Use the Hi-Vis Orange colour to your advantage by keeping the gloves clean. Grime and oil can reduce the "fluorescence" of the orange, making you less visible to colleagues.
- **Sizing:** A snug fit is vital. If the glove is too loose, you lose "feel" for the chainsaw

trigger; if too tight, it can cause hand fatigue during long shifts.
