Pro-Tips for Longevity

Avoid Water: Leather stiffens and cracks after being soaked. If they get wet, air-dry them slowly away from direct heat sources.

Storage: Store your gauntlets in a cool, dry place. Hanging them by the cuff helps maintain their shape and allows moisture from sweat to evaporate.

Rotation: If you weld daily, rotating between two pairs allows the leather fibres to recover and extends the life of both pairs.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

Q: Are these gloves suitable for TIG welding?

A: While these provide excellent protection, TIG welding usually requires more dexterity. These gauntlets are optimised for **MIG and Stick welding** where heat protection is the priority. For TIG, we recommend our goatskin range.

Q: Do they protect against electrical shocks?

A: Leather provides some natural insulation, but these are designed for **thermal and mechanical protection**, not as primary electrical insulation. Always follow standard welding safety protocols.

Q: How do I clean my welding gauntlets?

A: Do not machine wash. Use a stiff brush to remove surface slag and dirt. For deep cleans, use a specialised leather cleaner or a damp cloth with mild saddle soap.
